- 1) Technology overview
- 2) Go-to-market strategy
- 3) Competitive advantages
- 4) Next few milestones for the company (18 to 24 months) that would cover technology, business, and funding
- 5) Possible collaborations scenarios with Siemens
- 6) Information about the company founders
